We recently installed two granite benches on footings and Carol is having plaques made. We would like to continue research on hardscaping around the gate- it is always a mud patch. Rick has started with costing and Carol thinks it will enhance the cemetery. We would also like to create a space for green burial which will require the removal of stumps and bushes to make it suitable. At the last meeting we talked about offering green burial and through the survey our members agree. K. Dexter mentioned that there are even more developments with green burial including a cryogenic variety.

A motion will be made by Rick Cheney to accept the grounds budget via email.

A 2023 donations proposal was presented by Carol. This proposal has already been accepted by the Donations Committee: Kate, Tom, K. Dexter and Carol. The committee has met and decided that it makes sense to stick with our current roster of organizations, which represent our interest in supporting arts and education.

Austin suggested the possibly of creating a grant with the UConn Library to write a narrative of Cheney Brothers, perhaps identifying an individual who may be interested. Andrea is currently seeking a master's degree in history and will need to write a thesis next summer so perhaps this could be something she undertakes. Kate suggested reading the chapter on Cheney Brothers in the book, "Yankee Dreamers and Doers".

Austin made a motion to approve the budget for 2024 donations. Kristin seconded and all were in favor.

It has been agreed by all that moving money to the Family Fund is not a good idea. Regarding succession, Kristin and Carol are moving forward with identifying solutions. Jerry suggested Robinson & Cole to discuss the non-profit formation and how it will live on without a family member as President. All agree that the physical management of the cemetery is important. Our relationship with the probate court in Manchester may be something worth researching. Space at the machine shop in Manchester could be used to store our files. Andrea expressed interest in managing the finances for the cemetery.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:55.
